"WORN OFF" OR PARTIALLY VISIBLE A.S.A. STICKERS ARE NOT ALLOWED OR ACCEPTED.

THE MANAGER IS ULTIMATELY RESPONSIBLE FOR GUARANTEEING THAT THE PLAYERS ON HIS /

HER TEAM FULLY OBEY THIS RULE. MORE THAN ONE PLAYER USING THE SAME BAT IN THE SAME

INNING IS PROHIBITED (AUTOMATIC OUT)

UNLESS UMPIRE APPROVAL AT COIN TOSS.

ANY PLAYER CAUGHT USING A NON-APPROVED BY A.S.A. BAT OR A SUSPECTED OR VERIFIED ALTERED BAT WILL

BE EJECTED FROM THE GAME AND AN AUTOMATIC OUT WILL BE DECLARED. THE BATTER DOES NOT HAVE TO HIT OR SWING AT THE BALL.
